

scripture Journaling

WITH ART

OR

WITHOUT ART

*Materials:

- Journaling Bible OR Bible and separate journal
- Pencil

Optional:

- Color pencils
- Crayola Twistables
- Color markers
- Stickers

- Fine tip pen
- Stamps and stamp pads
- Washi tape
- Any art supplies you have on hand
- 1. Gather your materials. Sometimes it's fun to turn on some Christian music while you work.
- 2. Choose a Scripture verse or passage to journal.
- 3. Read your verse and think about it. How do you want to journal this verse?
 - Words only?
 - Words and stickers?
 - Drawing?
 - Writing out the verse?

- Writing out your thoughts about the verse?
- Writing out song lyrics that go with the verse?
- 4. Have fun journaling your Scripture. There is absolutely no right or wrong way to Scripture journal. You cannot do it the wrong way!

 Don't forget to meditate on your Scripture as you work. (Meditating simply means to think on the verse.)
- 5. Date your entry. It's fun to look back at your work later.

^{*}If you are working in a Journaling Bible, be careful not to use materials that will bleed through your pages. You can test your materials on a blank page in the back of your Bible.
